GET ME TO THE CHURCH ON TIME

If you choose to exchange your vows in a church, all your arrangements should be made directly with the venue of your choice.

After your service, your special day at Peak Edge will commence with your drinks reception upon arrival. For your day to flow beautifully, an ideal arrival time would be around 2:00pm – 2:30pm, however we can be totally flexible to meet your requirements.

CIVIL CEREMONIES

For those of you who want to enjoy a full day in one stylish venue, you can host your civil ceremony or partnership at Peak Edge with views of the rolling landscape.

A civil ceremony or partnership at Peak Edge costs £575 and the registrar will also apply their own costs. This is unfortunately not something we are able to organise for you. Once a date has been provisionally reserved with us, we do urge you to call the Chesterfield Registry Office on 01629 533111 to discuss dates, times, and fees.

A little tip: we recommend that the ideal ceremony takes place between 12:30pm – 2:00pm. The ceremony takes 20 minutes, and this just allows the day to flow perfectly.





To give you a little inspiration for your special day, here are some examples of weddings that people have had at Peak Edge.

A LAVISH CELEBRATION

On a crisp spring afternoon in May, Tom and Samantha married at Peak Edge. They enjoyed a lavish celebration in the Oak Room, alongside 50 of their closest family and friends.

With a glass of champagne per person on arrival, they enjoyed a civil ceremony surrounded by the spectacular backdrop of the Peak District. After the ceremony, photographs were taken by the lake in the glorious Derbyshire sunshine, the highland calves to be seen gambolling in the surrounding fields. After the ceremony, guests gathered in the foyer with glasses brimmed with bubbles and a selection of canapés served. Bottles of Champagne and house wine were placed on the tables for guests to enjoy and the newly wedded welcomed into the suite with an erupted cheer. A three-course feast was enjoyed, beginning with crisp pork fritters from Walton Lodge Farm with celeriac remoulade, followed by pan-fried seabass laced with a lemon and chive butter sauce.

As a little something sweet to finish, a warm Bakewell tart with Derbyshire clotted cream was served, before guests were gifted with a glass of champagne for post-dinner speeches. As night time drew in, the chandeliers lowered ahead of evening celebrations. The dancefloor laid and live entertainment set, guests were then welcomed with Champagne back into the Oak Room. A saxophonist began the evening entertainment with some soulful sounds, followed by a live DJ. A selection of fresh woodfired pizzas were then served for those feeling a little peckish, before the newlyweds were welcomed to the floor for the first dance. They later retired to the Chatsworth Suite, with warm fluffy robes and slippers awaiting. A freshly cooked breakfast was enjoyed in the room the following morning. A marriage made in heaven.

Tom and Samantha's special day cost of total of £14,800 for 50 guests for the entire day.



A CELEBRATION OF LOVE

Beginning the new year in style, Mark and Emma married at Peak Edge on Saturday 9th January 2019. Their celebration of love was shared with 160 guests in an extravagant ceremony held in the Oak Room.

The couple treated guests to an assortment of canapés, alongside a choice of either a glass of Champagne or bottle of beer, whilst white linen table cloths were laid and centre-pieces adjusted ahead of the wedding breakfast. Pan fried scallops were served to start, followed by a beetroot wellington,

and to finish a zestful lemon tart and raspberry sorbet. Bottles of wine were placed on each of the tables for guests to fill up a glass at their leisure. In the evening an additional 40 guests arrived with a glass of Champagne for each on arrival. A chicken and chorizo paella bursting with flavour was served to the 200 evening guests on the terrace, as the sun set in the Derbyshire Peak District.

The total cost of this celebration was £19,350 based on 160 daytime guests and 200 evening guests.

John and Pippa wedded at Peak Edge on a sunny Friday in May 2019. Along with 100 guests, their ceremony was hosted outside in the pagoda with the beautiful Derbyshire countryside as the backdrop.

After the ceremony, a selection of canapés were served on the lawn, including smoked salmon and rye bread croûte with avocado, before guests were then led into the Oak Room to enjoy the wedding breakfast ahead. An amuse-bouche began the afternoon and was followed with a choice of glazed goat's cheese with romesco sauce, ham hock terrine with red onion chutney, crispy pork fritters or seasonal soup with fresh crusty bread. A fillet of Walton Lodge Derbyshire beef followed

with additional main options including; honey and mustard roasted pork chop, beetroot wellington or gnocchi served with tangy sundried tomato salsa and a rocket and pesto cream. On a sweeter note, sticky toffee pudding with caramel sauce, red berry crème brûlée or warm Bakewell tart with local cream were amongst the dessert options. For the evening reception, an additional 80 guests arrived to celebrate the newlyweds. A selection of popular street food dishes was served bringing guests together out on the Oak Room terrace as the sun set on the Derbyshire peaks. A day written in the stars.

The total cost of this day was £16,850 for 100 daytime guests and 180 evening guests.

With a glass of Champagne upon arrival for each of their guests, a delicious wedding breakfast was served. Our award-winning kitchen team prepared chicken liver parfait with fig chutney and brioche toast to start. For main, pan-fried salmon with crushed new potatoes, cream leeks, asparagus and a caper and dill cream sauce, and to finish a white chocolate and berry roulade served with local

strawberry ice cream. The house white wine was chosen and available on each table to accompany the food. An additional 20 guests arrived for the evening celebrations, greeted with a glass of Champagne on arrival. A feast for the eyes was served in the form of an artisan deli with large platters of meats, chutneys, local cheeses and freshly baked homemade breads laid out to fuel an evening of celebrations and dancing.

This celebration equated to a total cost of £14,000 with 80 daytime guests and 100 evening guests.





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
