

# WALK 1 – Stanedge Golf Course to Holymoorside via the woods

**Circular Route** 



Distance 3.3 miles



**Duration 1:30h** 

A pleasant, circular walk which drops down into some woodland, there is a short walk along a quiet road that runs parallel to Corporation Wood. It re-enters the woods, where you will cross some beautiful streams and pass a small waterfall before passing through a farm and returning to the Peak Edge Hotel. Advisory: We recommend dogs be kept on a lead and please wear appropriate footwear as the walk can be muddy in places. Finally, be aware of flying golf balls!

- 1. Walk out of the Peak Edge Hotel car park and turn left, walk along the grass verge for about 150 yards, until you are opposite the sign for Stanedge Golf Course.
- 2. Take this road, heading towards the golf course. The road has a slight incline and then bends round to the right. You will see some incredible views here! Walk past the clubhouse on the left and keep walking straight on past the farm, also on the left.
- 3. Once you have passed the farm, there will be a little pond on the right and a public footpath sign on the left, take the footpath down along the edge of the golf course until you come to an opening on your right.
- 4. Follow this path into the woods (it can be very muddy at times) and keep following for about quarter of a mile, it will bend round to the left and descend slightly.
- 5. Once you get further down, climb over the dry stone wall stile and continue walking straight ahead.
- 6. Proceed straight on, go through the gate ahead of you and keep going until you get to the walk-through, then turn left.
- 7. Walk to the top of the road and turn left again, heading up the road for about guarter of a mile, be sure to take in the beautiful views of Corporation Wood.
- 8. After about quarter of a mile you will see a path leading into the woods on the left, marked by a boulder. Follow the path until you reach a little bridge crossing a stream, go over the bridge and continue following the path straight up. There is a small waterfall as you cross the bridge and the remains of an old, beautiful stone building.
- 9. Follow the path up along the stream, (which you have to cross twice along the way, using the stepping stones). After crossing the stream at the very top, follow the path that runs along the dry stone wall and go through the gate.
- 10. You will then come to a farm, turn left and head up the road and out of the farm, this eventually leads you back onto Darley Road. Turn left at the top, walking about 200 yards along the grass verge until you are back at the Peak Edge Hotel.
