

## WALK 3 - Stone Edge Chimney (Monument) Stroll

Circular Route

Distance 1.2 miles

Duration 0:30h

Stretch your legs and visit the oldest industrial chimney in Britain, built c. 1770!

A beautiful short walk, just a stone's throw from the Peak Edge Hotel. Take in a piece of history whilst enjoying the surrounding stunning scenery. Advisory: We recommend dogs be kept on a lead and please wear appropriate footwear as the walk can be muddy in places.

- 1. Take a left out of Peak Edge Hotel car park and walk along the grass verge for about 250 yards until you get to Belland Lane. Follow the lane up for another 100 yards, until you see a public footpath sign on the right. From here you get a good view of Peak Edge Hotel and the monument.
- 2. Enter the footpath over the walled stile and follow it to the monument.
- 3. Once you have admired the monument, head back onto the path and follow it over to the pond area. Walk along, between the ponds until you get to a little sparse wooded area, follow the arrow into the woods and go round to the right. It is rather small but soon you will come to another walled stile. Feel free to continue along the path here but beware of cows. If you look at the map you can extend the walk back around to Belland Lane and onto Matlock Road. Or you can turn around and head back through the wooded area and around the ponds.
- 4. This time take a right turn at the ponds and head up the dirt track that leads you back onto Belland Lane. From here you can walk back down the lane and return to the hotel.
- 5. There is an option to turn left and visit our neighbour's establishment 'Highfield House Farm Shop'.
